I wanted to write and thank you for my recent Russian brown bear hunt. This hunt was successful, and downright fun. I would call the hunt an “adventure of a lifetime”!

This all started in September 2009 when I was returning from a botched Alaskan bear hunt. If something “sounds too good to be true” it usually is, and this was the story on my Outfitter in Alaska. Poor planning and worst scouting on his part made for a very poor hunt. Unfortunately, not the first bad hunt in Alaska either. I emailed you from the hotel in Anchorage while waiting for my flight home, and booked my reservation for this spring’s hunt. This turned out to be a great decision. As all seven hunters in my group got their bear.

You had all the required paperwork (import license for rifles, Russian visa, etc) done well in advance, so that clearing Russian customs was very little trouble. And returning to the US was even less trouble, even with bringing back our bears.

The hunt itself was in true wilderness. The Russian guides knew the area, knew their business, worked hard for us, and were really friendly. With the “in camp translator” communication was very little trouble. I will remember the blonde phase bear that I took for the rest of my life. The food in camp was good, hot, and plenty of it. Having been on several guided hunts this one really stands out.

Growing up during the “Cold War” I didn’t know what to expect from the Russian people. But, everyone that we had any close contact was really friendly. Several thought it was cool that Americans were visiting, and enough of the Russians spoke English that communication was no real problem.

I want you to especially thank the outfitter for being savvy enough to take us in by snow machines our first day out rather than sit in town, for who knows how many days, before the helicopter would fly. Even though I hated the ride from town to camp, it was better than sitting in town. At least I got to hunt a full week rather than waste time in town. Great planning! Saved our hunt as we would not have gotten out the last day as well. And thankfully, Serge, our driver had a GPS so we were able to navigate our way out of the blizzard on the way back to town after the hunt. I thought we would wind up having to go back to camp for days. Kudos to the outfitter!

I plan to take another Russian hunt with you in the future, maybe for moose or grizzly bear. If I’d have had any more fun on this hunt it would have been illegal. Thanks again!
